In Memoriam: Prof. Dudley A. Saville

With deepest regrets we must report that Dudley A. Saville, Stephen C. MacAleer '63 Professor of Engineering and Applied Science, Professor of Chemical Engineering, passed away the morning of Wednesday, October 4, 2006.

Professor Saville began his career at Princeton as an assistant professor on September 1, 1968. He was promoted to associate professor on July 1, 1971 and to professor on July 1, 1977.

Professor Saville is survived by his wife, Joy Saville, 244 Dodds Lane, Princeton, NJ; his son Alex Saville and his wife Amy Jacob of Highland Park, NJ; his daughter Andrea White and her husband Stephen White of Princeton, NJ; and his grandson Aidan Saville White, son of Andrea and Steve.

A memorial service is scheduled for Sunday, October 8, at 4:30 p.m. at Nassau Presbyterian Church. The University flag will fly at half mast over East Pyne Hall in his honor Thursday, October 5 through Sunday, October 8.
